

FOOD SAFETY IS YOUR BUSINESS

ACT Health, in collaboration with Canberra Business Chamber, will be holding an information session to support food businesses and help them understand and comply with food safety requirements.

This event will focus on:

- common compliance issues found during inspections,
- advice to avoid these compliance issues, and
- tools that are available to assist food businesses to achieve compliance with food safety requirements.

Public Health Officers will be available at this event to answer any compliance questions. We encourage food business proprietors or staff to attend and seek clarification on food safety issues in a casual setting.

The event will also allow ACT Health to engage with food businesses and industry representatives on the national consultation for the *Ministerial Policy Guideline on Food Safety Management for General Food Service and Closely Related Retail Sectors* (the Policy Guideline).

The Policy Guideline provides a framework for the development of nationally consistent food safety arrangements in Australia to improve food safety management and culture. The national engagement aims to identify, test and refine options to improve food safety outcomes in food businesses.

The consultation is your opportunity as a food business operator to comment on your experiences of regulatory and non-regulatory food safety measures that have already been implemented in the ACT. DATE
