Southern Harvest Association, with the support of the Bungendore Chamber of Commerce and Industry and Queanbeyan Palerang Regional Council are organising the Bungendore Harvest Festival and invite local businesses to participate.

AIMS OF THE BUNGENDORE HARVEST FESTIVAL

- Promote Bungendore and QPRC as a regional food destination
- Bring overnight and day visitor tourism to Bungendore
- Profile regional food
- Celebrate our farming history
- Help to create a community feel for Bungendore

EVENT SNAPSHOT

The Bungendore Harvest Festival will be a celebration of local, cold climate food, how it grows, where it grows, where to get it, how to prepare it and how to eat it. The weekend Festival will occur across a weekend to encourage overnight visitors and people from further afield.

On **Friday evening**, local food venues will be encouraged to showcase locally sourced food and drinks on their menus for the enjoyment of locals and visitors alike.

On **Saturday**, the streets of Bungendore will come alive with stalls, talks, cooking demonstrations and other activities that are inviting and attractive to locals and visitors alike. The Festival will take place in marquees along the footpaths in Ellendon Street, at the Carrington Hotel, in the vacant blocks along Ellendon Street and at the Village Square. Stalls along Ellendon Street will include food stalls from local farmers and will include garlic, tomatoes, fruit and other seasonal vegetables and produce, as well as food preserved from local harvests. Stallholders will operate from 10am - 4pm (set up from 8am to 9:30am, pull down from 4pm) and may not pack up prior to 4pm.

On **Saturday evening**, local food venues will be encouraged to showcase locally sourced food and drinks on their menus for the enjoyment of locals and visitors alike. We would also like to provide some family friendly activities such as a short movie screening and picnic setting.

Sunday will see visitors explore and recognise Bungendore as a regional food destination. Visitors will participate in farm and winery tours, sample Bungendore's freshest and finest local food at local cafes and restaurants, and attend courses focused on growing and preserving food.

The Bungendore Harvest Festival will engage as many local businesses to participate in the Harvest Festival as possible, and has the support of the Queanbeyan Palerang Regional Council and the Bungendore Chamber of Commerce and Industry.



HOW CAN I GET INVOLVED?

Businesses are invited to host events that are relevant to the aims of the Bungendore Harvest Festival. Even if your business is not associated with food, you can participate. Participating in the festival in some way that is promoted on the Festival Program will help get potential customers in your door. Your participation also demonstrates your commitment to creating a vibrant Bungendore business community.

1. Hold an event at your place of business
2. Do a tour or tasting event (particularly for farms and wineries)
3. Do a demonstration or presentation (cooking demonstrations would be great!)
4. Sponsor the event
5. Donate a prize

HOLD AN EVENT AT YOUR PLACE OF BUSINESS

- Some ideas include, but are not limited to:
- Food venues can feature local food and beverages on their menu. We can put you in touch with suppliers.
- Cooking demonstrations or classes
- Taste tests
- Wine appreciation class (a liquor license will be required)
- Host a short talk about something related to food, gardening, or sustainability. **We can match you with a presenter who needs a venue if needed.**
- Run a competition and offer a prize. Eg. biggest pumpkin, children's vegie growing, a guessing competition.
- Offer children's activities relevant to the Bungendore Harvest Festival's aims.
- Create a display relevant to the aims of the festival.
- Farm or winery tours (recommended for Sunday)
- Run courses or workshops on growing or preserving food

ORGANISE A FARM TOUR

SATURDAY and SUNDAY 17 and 18 March – EXPLORE THE REGION

Saturday 17 and Sunday 18 March will see visitors explore and recognise Bungendore as a regional food destination. Visitors will participate in farm and winery tours, sample Bungendore's freshest and finest local food at local cafes and restaurants, attend courses focused on growing, cooking and preserving food or wine appreciation classes. These are suggestions and you are most welcome to come up with your own ideas.

Southern Harvest Association has approval from QPRC to run a one day series of Farm Tours (or similar) as part of the Bungendore Harvest Festival. Alternatively, it may suit you to run a demonstration on farm or run a workshop rather than having an open farm or farm tours.

Farms are encouraged to set a limit on numbers and times in order that numbers can be managed.

COUNCIL REQUIREMENTS

QPRC is agreeable that a fee may be charged for visits but we must donate part of this money to charity.

If you simply want us to advertise your open farm or local produce shop then we can do this too, however if you are charging for entry and do not have a development application lodged with Council you will need to return funds to charity. Refer to "Your Return" on the next page.

Farms may sell produce at the time of the visit, but only if it is produced on farm. Specifically, QPRC has advised that meat producers are not able to sell meat directly to consumers from their farms unless they have approval from council to do so.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

Local businesses will not be charged to participate in the Bungendore Harvest Festival unless you would like us to list your event and sell tickets, but we do need to know if you are participating so your business can be included in the program.

Upon receiving your Business Activity Notification Form by the due date, Southern Harvest will undertake the following:

- List your event in the online and printed Festival Program
- Promote your event on the Southern Harvest Association's Facebook page.

Southern Harvest Association is a community and business lead not-for-profit incorporated regional food organisation at the forefront of promoting local food production and consumption in the ACT and Southern NSW.

FARM/WINERY TOUR

Summary and Invitation to Participate in a Farm or Winery Tour	
Eligibility	Farms, wineries, gardens and businesses within the Southern Harvest region in food, fibre and agricultural related industries.
Location	Your farm or winery
Date	Saturday 17 th or Sunday 18 th March 2018
Time	You decide. We recommend 2 or 3 tours on the day lasting from 1 - 1.5 hours each, which gives people time to get to the next farm if they want to do more than one tour.
<u>Suggested prices</u>	\$20 per adult or \$50 per family.
Bookings	For your convenience, Southern Harvest can manage your bookings. The Southern Harvest website is equipped with a booking system and can accept online payments. It is expected that farms managing their own bookings remit to Southern Harvest 50% of tour takings. Refer to "Your return" below for details.
Your return	50% of the tour price will be returned to the farmer. 50% will be shared between charity and Southern Harvest. Funds allocated to Southern Harvest offset operational costs associated with the Bungendore Harvest Festival, including advertising your farm or winery tour.
Public Liability Insurance	To participate, Southern Harvest requires participating venues to have Public Liability Insurance to the amount of at least \$10 million. A copy of your public liability certificate must accompany your application. If you don't have public liability insurance that covers this type of activity, then unfortunately you will not be able to participate as we are unable to extend our insurance coverage to you for farm activities.
